We are still looking for someone to fill the position for Custodian by March! *If you are interested please see Dave Rice.*



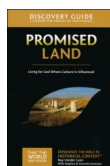

### Winter Women's Bible Study

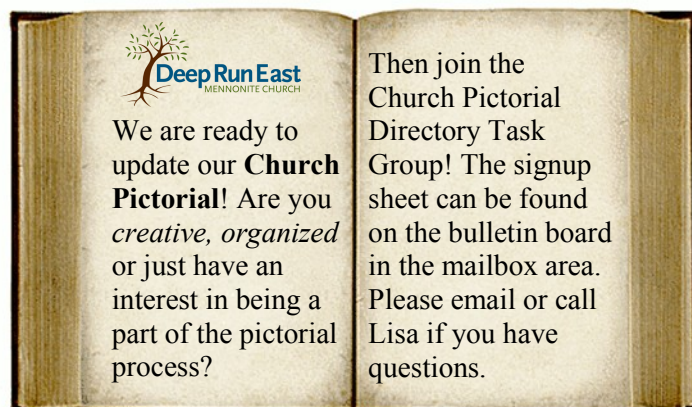
