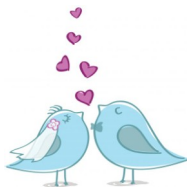
This year our 6-8<sup>th</sup> graders will be learning about what it means to find our REFUGE in Jesus!

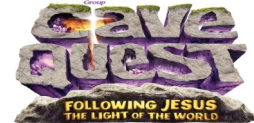
### Wilderness Camp
