Living the 80/20 Way by Richard Koch

“The 10-20 minutes before children fall asleep are the most priceless and influential. Reading a suitable story demonstrates love and sends the child off with a store of dreaming material. One friend’s kids love their bedtime stories, because dad makes up stories that include them as key characters. You can work out the stories in advance or ask imaginative friends for ideas. Give the value of this time, both to the children directly and in cementing your bond with them, make this a daily habit. The effort is small-the reward enormous.”
