If you would like to contribute to our project, you can help by donating money in the jar in the sanctuary or you can buy one or more of the following supplies and place them beside this table.

Each kit contains the following:

- 2 gowns/sleepers (flannel or similar warm, soft material)
- 2 undershirts/onesies (short or long sleeves)
- 4 cloth diapers (flat-fold preferred)
- 1 receiving blanket (light weight fleece or flannel; minimum 36 in / 92cm)
- 4 safety pins (2in / 5cm)
- 1 large bar mild soap (leave in wrapper)
- 1 pair of socks
- 1 cap
