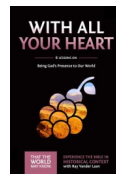


Deep Run East PRESCHOOL Announcements It's Registration time!

Wednesday Spanish Enrichment Class and **Friday TOT Time** are being offered again this year. Be sure to register before the end of summer!

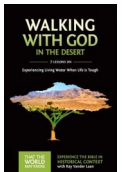

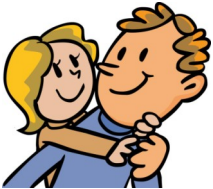
